DRESS CODE

UNIFORM TOP

- All students must wear the Harmony School uniform shirt.
- Long sleeve shirts may be worn under uniform shirt (navy blue, red, black, and white only; no hoods).
- Properly fitting navy blue, red, black and white sweater (only cardigan sweaters, no monogrammed sports pull over. Knitted sweaters that open downward the full length of the front, button or zipper are OK.
- Shirt is in good condition. Free from holes and tears.
- Shirts must be long enough to tuck in and stay tucked in all day. Shirt will remain tucked in at all times before, during and after school, whenever on school campus.
- Shirts are properly tucked in so belt is visible all the way around.
- Shirt collars and sleeves must remain down.

DRESS CODE

PANTS.

- ❑ Properly fitting navy blue or khaki pants.
- ❑ Properly fitting navy blue or khaki shorts (K-8)
 - ❑ Shorts must be to the knee or longer. No skirts are allowed.
- ❑ Black, brown or dark blue fitted belt.
- ❑ No jeans or cargo-style pants may be worn.
- ❑ Pants may not be baggy or sag or have a low waistline.
- ❑ Pants must be worn properly at the waist.
- ❑ Pant legs may not be rolled up.
- ❑ Belts must fit properly and not hang down when buckled. No big buckles allowed.

DRESS CODE

FOOTWEAR

- ❑ **Socks:** White, navy, blue or black must be worn at all times. No “footies” are allowed.
- ❑ **Shoes:** Dark-colored lace-up shoes or loafers with closed toe/heel), athletic shoes must be black, brown, navy or white only. **No other colors!**
- ❑ No sandals, boots, mules, “Ugs”, high heels, flip flops, crocs, skate shoes, open toe/heel
- ❑ All shoes should have backs or secure straps on back of shoe for safety and always remain tied. Pants must cover your shoes.

Personal Appearance

- ❑ No facial or body piercing allowed.
- ❑ No clip-on jewelry (earrings, nose rings, etc.) is allowed. Girls may wear stud earrings; no large dangling or hoop earrings are allowed. Boys may not wear earrings.
- ❑ No tattoos (permanent or temporary) are allowed.
- ❑ No extreme hairstyles (Mohawk and spiked up) or extreme colored hair are allowed. Boys' hair may not pass the neck. Sideburns may be tip of the ear lobe.
- ❑ Sunglasses are not permitted.
- ❑ Wallets with long chains are not permitted.
- ❑ Girls may wear tasteful make-up and nail polish that does not call attention to the student. Necklaces must be worn inside the shirt. (choking hazard)

Outerwear

- ❑ No hats, caps, bandannas, or other headwear are allowed.
- ❑ No outerwear, such as windbreakers, jean jackets, or ski jackets, may be worn inside the classroom. Such items must be stored in your PE locker (6-8).
- ❑ “Hoodies” may not be worn in the building. Tuck in the hood.
- ❑ No pullovers or sweatshirts are allowed.

Free Dress Code Days

- All general guidelines apply for free dress days.
- Garments must be free of holes, tears, inappropriate wording, logos, messages or advertising. Clothing items must not depict images of violence.
- No short, skintight, or bicycle legging dresses or skirts may be worn.
- All dresses must have sleeves
- No low cut, midriff-baring, or backless blouses.
- Students may wear jeans but they cannot be skin tight.

Student IDs

- Students will be issued school ids soon.
- Students IDs must be visible and worn at all times.
- IDs will be checked every morning.
- They will be scanned during lunch to keep track of your breakfast/lunch balance.
